## Appeals court rules that woman in Ally Steinfeld death should get evidentiary hearing

Missouri's Southern District Court of Appeals has ruled that a suspect in a trans Texas County teen's 2017 murder will get an evidentiary hearing, according to court documents.

The ruling came May 31.

Isis Schauer was one of two young women who told authorities they helped burn 17-year-old Ally Steinfeld's body after a man gouged out Steinfeld's eyes, repeatedly stabbed the teen and bragged about the killing near Cabool, according to court records. The other, Briana Calderas, pleaded guilty to abandonment of a corpse, concealing a felony and tampering with physical evidence in a felony prosecution. She was sentenced to eight years in 2019 and has since been paroled.

Andrew Vrba, the Houston man who stabbed Steinfeld, was found guilty of first-degree murder and armed criminal action in November 2020, and was sentenced to life in prison. He is incarcerated at the Potosi Correctional Center in Mineral Point. Another co-defendant, James Grigsby, pleaded guilty to abandonment of a corpse, was sentenced to four years and has been paroled.

### ABOUT THE SCHAUER CASE

Schauer pleaded guilty to second-degree murder and abandonment of a corpse in December 2017. She

is held in Chillicothe.

At the time, she testified that she understood the charges against her and that her decision to plead guilty was voluntary, according to court records. However, in June 2018, Schauer filed a post-conviction motion, claiming that the public defender who repre-

sented her was ineffective.

In addition to the attorney not adequately investigating the case, Schauer said that she was told "if she didn't plead guilty, she would get the death penalty," according to court records. She also filed an amended motion where she alleged she pleaded guilty due to fears that she would not be adequately represented in subsequent proceedings, as her attorney told her that they were withdrawing from representation after the plea hearing to take another job. Schauer also alleges that though she was "adamant" she was not guilty of the murder charge, she felt she had to plead guilty.

The motion court dismissed Schauer's motion in January 2022, after which she filed an appeal.

The three-member appellate court agreed with Schauer that she should have been granted an evidentiary hearing before her motions were rejected, and sent the case back to circuit court for that purpose. John Beger is the circuit judge.

"After examining the whole record, we are firmly convinced that a mistake has been made and that the motion court's ruling was clearly erroneous," the court records state.

Had Schauer given testimony like the amended plea at an evidentiary hearing and it was found credible, "evidence of this nature would cast serious doubt as to whether the answers Schauer gave during the plea hearing were voluntary and truthful."

## Workforce development grant awarded in south-central Missouri

A south-central Missouri project is among 28 projects in the Delta Regional Authority awarded \$11.7 million.

Missouri State University-West Plains was awarded more than \$437,000 from the federal initiative to engage unemployed or underemployed adults, veterans, high school youth, incumbent workers and other underrepresented groups through education and career training within the manufacturing and construction sections.

"The Delta Workforce Grant Program (DWP) makes targeted investments in initiatives and programs that support workforce employment and training needs in DRA's region and helps create pathways to high-quality careers that allow residents to thrive and remain in their communities," said DRA Federal Co-Chairman Dr. Corey Wiggins. "As a result of this investment, nearly 3,800 individuals are projected to receive industry-driven skills training for high-demand jobs in their communities, helping to strengthen local workforce ecosystems and econom-

ic vitality throughout the region."

DRA made available grants ranging from \$50,000 - \$450,000 to address the employment and training needs of the local and regional workforce, created in collaboration with community partners and aligned with existing economic and workforce development plans and strategies. Programs funded through DWP provide workforce training and education to individuals residing in the eight-state DRA region and include at least one employer partner seeking to hire more skilled workers in a high-demand industry sector. The majority of DRA's investments are made in communities that have been underserved, discriminated against, and adversely affected by persistent poverty and inequality. DRA remains committed to strategies to advance equity in the region.

### HOW THE MONEY WILL BE USED

The money will be used to hire a second welding instructor and develop a

night welding program that will double the number of students trained for area welding jobs, said MSU-WP Workforce Development Director Sheila Barton.

"We are so grateful for this grant! It will allow us to train more students in a skilled trade that will support the local and regional workforce," Barton said.

"Once again, the Delta Regional Authority is coming alongside Missouri State-West Plains as we increase our workforce development capabilities, especially as it regards the Pace Welding Program," MSU-WP Chancellor Dennis Lancaster said. "We're thankful for the investment in our program and our community, where highly skilled welders always seem to be needed among our manufacturing partners."

MSU-WP's current workforce development programs focus on entry level industry technician training in the areas of advanced welding and fabrication, advanced manufacturing, mecha-

tronics and manufacturing management, Barton explained.

This grant money will specifically focus on building the capacity of the Terry L. 'Bo' Pace Advanced Welding and Fabrication Technology Program from 15 to 30 students, thus creating economic transformation for families and continuing a positive economic impact in the region by creating a pipeline of skilled labor for local and regional industry, she said.

According to the Missouri Economic Research and Information Center (MERIC), manufacturers in MSU-WP's seven-county service area report they have more than 100 job openings for maintenance technicians, welders/fabricators and various other types of manufacturing sector jobs. Further, employers indicate they expect to hire an additional 500 workers over the next four to six years. Salaries for these positions range from \$40,000 to \$50,000, according to O\*Net Online, an online tool for career exploration and job analysis.
