New food provider at Fort Leonard Wood

Fort Leonard Wood received a new food service provider.

The State of Missouri canceled its subcontract with EDP Enterprises Inc. as the food service provider for Fort Leonard Wood on May 15.

According to a Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Notice, EDP terminated its operation at Fort Leonard Wood at the close of business on June 14.

In the notice, Vice President of Food Operations Terry Strief said, "This is expected to be a perma-

nent closure of the entire EDP operation at Fort Leonard Wood."

Many of the impacted employees are represented by a union, the National Association of Government Employees (NAGE) Local R14-139.

Strief said union officials had been contacted.

Joseph Savage, director of human resources for Blackstone Consulting, said it will be the new food service provider at Fort Leonard Wood, and all 948 employees will keep their jobs and become Blackstone employees effective June 14.

Potential data breach at Cox Health

CoxHealth patients may be receiving a letter in the mail soon about a potential data breach.

One of the hospital system's billing vendors, Intellihartx, LLC, was among the companies impacted by the Fortra GoAnywhere "zero-day" breach earlier this year. Intellihartx estimates that about 203,000 CoxHealth patients may have been affected, and is mailing out notices.


The breach included patient medical billing and in-

urance information such as name, address, date of birth, Social Security number and diagnosis.

"It should be noted that analysts arrived at that number out of an abundance of caution. In the forensic review, analysts were not able to limit the scope with absolute certainty," CoxHealth said in a statement. "So, to be safe, (Intellihartx) and their forensic auditors are considering any folders that were breached as potential points of risk."

Fortra is a cybersecurity company, and its application GoAnywhere is used to securely transfer files over a network. According to Fortra's website, GoAnywhere is used by companies like KwikTrip, Northwestern University and Braum's Ice Cream.

The vendor is offering complimentary access to Experian IdentityWorks identity theft protection for 12 months, and patients with questions may call Intellihartx's toll-free assistance line at 833-901-4622.
